# **Getting Started:**

- Step 1: Login to www.performanceassessmentresourcebank.org
- Step 2: Choose "Submit a Resource" from the top menu/dashboard.



Step 3: Fill out the submission form to the best of your ability, including whatever information about the resource (i.e. a performance task) that you can give us. You will also be prompted to upload associated materials, such as rubrics, student instructions, and unit plans.

## **After Submission:**

After hitting "submit", we will route your resource through the review process. Once the review is complete, you will get an email notification with your review status. In many cases, we may suggest that you make some minor revisions to tasks in order to meet our quality criteria.

You will be directed to access your review details, which includes comments and ratings according to the quality criteria, under "My Resources" and then the "Submitted Resources" tab on the site.
